

TypeA

The candidate must have passed class 8, 9, and 10 from a recognized institute with a minimum aggregate of 35% For direct admission to the second year, the candidate must have passed class 12 in the relevant stream.

TypeB

The candidates who do not fall under Type A but have parents with Maharashtra State Domicile.

TypeC

The candidates who fall neither in Type A nor in Type B but have parents posted in Maharashtra in a government job at the time of filling the form.

TypeD

The candidates do not fall under Type A, Type B, or Type C but have a father or mother as an employee or retired employee of the Government of Maharashtra or Government of Maharashtra Undertakings.

TypeE


The candidate must have passed classes 8, 9, and 10 from a recognized institute located under the Maharashtra border with fluency in the Marathi language.





Maharashtra Polytechnic Admissions Process **202**4

- Visit the official website.
- Register with a valid email ID and password.
- Fill in the required details that are asked in the application form.
- Upload the documents asked to submit.
- Pay the application fee through supported online methods. The application fee for the General category candidates and the candidates belonging to other states is INR 400. While the application fee for the reserved category candidates from Maharashtra is INR 300.
- Click on the 'Submit' button after the payment of the application fee.
- The merit list prepared based on the filled data will determine the admission into the diploma course.
- The applicants are required to visit the 'Facilitation' Centres' for document verification.










Dates Timeline (Tentative)
